

Provision is made for a total of 17,140 additional homes in the period to 2031, with notional delivery across the period as indicated below.

Westgate Town Council's concerns

Use of a one size fits all methodology to work out the "Objectively Assessed Housing Need" does not take into account the uniqueness of Thanet:

- High unemployment
- Over stretched services such as doctors and the care system
- Lack of brown field site

Grade one agricultural land

- Only a small percentage of this top quality soil in the country
- We need this land food production
- Flood reduction, home for birds and wildlife and also carbon sink.

Infrastructure.
Doctors, NHS.
Water and sewerage.
