COVID-19 RECOMMENDATIONS

- Use hand sanitiser before opening and closing any gate locks. Please note the Westgate-on-Sea Town council recommend that you wear gloves, where possible, when unlocking and locking the gate padlock.
- If possible keep hand sanitiser in your shed and wash your hands regularly.
- DO NOT gather together for a chat even if you are 2 metres apart.
- Observe “Social Distancing” with each other 2-3 metres.
- Do not share tools.
- Do not wash your hands in water troughs. Use running water and soap where possible.
- Bonfires are banned on the Allotment Gardens from 1st April to 1st October inclusive each year for environmental reasons. Thanet District Council have now also advised that during the current Coronavirus outbreak they are advising residents to stop using bonfires as a way to dispose of their garden waste. Kent County Council’s Household Waste and Recycling Centres are currently closed. If you have any garden waste please store it responsibly until the facilities are reopened.
- Please note the Allotment Toilet will be closed for use from 17.04.2020 until further notice. Thanet District council have suspended use of Public Toilets.
