Bus Service Number 35	
Members were updated that KCC had taken onboard the Town Clerk's suggestion and the 35 Bus would now start from Mountfield Way at 9.30am allowing residents with bus passes to travel earlier in the morning.	
Members agreed the change in time would benefit bus pass users, but this did not address the problem of the 1 hour and 45 minute wait before a return journey could be made.	
The Sub-Committee goal is to ensure residents have an hourly transport service going to Mountfield Way.	
ACTION: To contact KCC to request an update on the proposal that the fourth No 8 bus every hour at 51 minutes past the hour is rerouted onto the Mountfield estate and whether KCC would support a handrail being installed to the footpath that leads from Ursuline Drive to Canterbury Road.	DTC
Cllr King talked to Members about funding Hadlow Parish Council received to provide a Mini Bus dial-a-ride service through Kent Karrier and it was discussed if a similar service could be offered in Westgate-on-Sea.
